
## About the park site:

This new park will be located within a mixed-density residential neighborhood in the Aloha area of Washington County. The site is composed of three properties located west of SW 187<sup>th</sup> Avenue and south of SW Bonnie Meadow Lane. The properties form a relatively flat 2.56 acre site that includes a stand of large native oak and ponderosa pine trees and an open grassy area.













## The process:

Community involvement is an essential part of the planning and design process. THPRD worked closely with neighbors and the broader community to ensure that the design and proposed use considers the needs of local residents.
