**2010 INDUSTRIAL SOFTBALL  
LEAGUE INFORMATION**



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**ALL PLAYERS PLAY AT THEIR OWN RISK**

**REGISTRATION PROCEDURES**

**The Men's and Coed INDUSTRIAL Softball league is open to employees from a THPRD tax paying COMPANY located within the Tualatin Hills Park and Recreation District boundaries. All but three players must be employed by the In-District company.**

**Rosters with the most company employees will be given priority for league entry.  
ALL PLAYERS PLAY AT THEIR OWN RISK.**

**LEAGUE ROSTERS**

1. The team roster must be completed in full, listing non-employee players first.
2. A player may be registered on only ONE Tualatin Hills Coed or Men's industrial team.
3. Players must be 17 years of age or older and finished with high school.
4. Rosters must list a minimum of 14 players and a maximum of 20.
5. Rosters may have three non-employees or a combination of ghost card and non-employees, not to exceed a total of three. For each non-employee player listed on the roster a copy of a valid THPRD Residency card must be submitted with the roster.
6. Rosters with the most company employees listed will be given priority for league entry if more than maximum number of teams apply. For team acceptance purposes, only the first 15 players listed on the roster will be counted.  
For each company employee listed on the roster a copy of a current (within three months) pay stub must be submitted with the team roster. The pay stub must list the company name, company address, employee name and date. Pay stubs may have pay information crossed out.
7. **Retired Employees:** A company roster may include players that have retired from the company. Retirees must provide proof of retirement from the company's HR department listing the date of retirement. Retirees must obtain a THPRD Residency ID card. Out of District players must pay the appropriate assessment fee.
8. All non-employee in-district and out-of-district players must submit a copy of a valid THPRD ID card with the team roster. Please see Out-of-District Fee Policy information sheet for details on how to receive a THPRD ID card.
9. If inadequate ID is presented (i.e. no pay stub submitted for an employee), DO NOT put the player on the roster. If this creates less than 14 players on the roster, the team may not be considered for the league. Non-employee out-of-district players may be added to the roster IF LEAGUE DOES NOT REACH THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TEAMS. If the league is at capacity, a non-employee out-of-district player on a team roster may be dropped and replaced with another non-employee out-of-district player (must be done at the same time).
10. Due to no industrial women's teams at this time, a maximum of two women will be allowed to play on a men's team.
11. Rosters will be checked for accuracy and may be checked by other teams upon request. If a roster has incorrect information on it, a team from the waiting list may take that team's place in the league.
12. Two teams from "small" companies may combine but must have a minimum of 5 employees from each company on the roster.

13. Teams not meeting the above criteria will be considered only on an individual basis and only if space is available. Regulations on those team rosters will be considered individually.

### **GHOST CARDS AVAILABLE**

1. Teams may purchase a maximum of two Sports ID cards called Ghost Cards in lieu of 2 of the 3 non-employee players. A ghost card can be used when short rostered players.
2. Ghost cards will cost \$31.00 each. Ghost cards will not be available after the rosters are submitted if the league fills with the maximum number of teams.
3. Ghost cards can be used when teams have less than 10 players and are short players for a game. Players can be anyone not currently playing in the THPRD industrial league.
4. GHOST CARDS CANNOT be used during any playoff game.

### **DEADLINE**

1. **DEADLINE: 7:00pm, Friday, April 30<sup>th</sup>**. Team roster, placement sheet, entry fee and copies of all required I.D. are due in the THPRD Sports office, 15707 SW Walker Road, Beaverton by **Friday, April 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm**.

### **LEAGUE FEES**

1. **MEN'S LEAGUE: \$486.00 per team.**
2. **COED LEAGUE: \$324.00 per team.**
3. Make checks payable to Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District (THPRD). Teams will also be required to pay \$29.00 for each Ghost Card.
4. League fees cover direct costs, which include umpires, game balls, rulebooks, scorebooks, awards and complex supervisors.
5. All fees are payable by cash, check or credit card and must be submitted with team roster.
6. Any team dropping from the league after the league schedules have been completed WILL NOT receive a refund of league fees unless there is a team to take their place.

### **TEAM SELECTION**

1. Minimum number of teams needed to have a league is 6.
2. Any fewer teams will not constitute a league and teams will be given a full refund of fees.
3. Notification of acceptance into the league will be mailed by May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
4. **MANAGERS' MEETING:** There **WILL NOT** be a managers' meeting for the Coed or Men's Industrial softball league. Rules, schedules and other information will be EMAILED to managers by May 20<sup>th</sup>.

## **LEAGUE STRUCTURE**

### **MEN'S DIVISION**

1. 14 games plus playoffs will be played.
2. A minimum of two games a week will be played.
3. A full refund will be given if there are fewer than six teams to form a league.

### **COED DIVISION**

- A. 12 games will be played. No playoffs will be scheduled unless scheduling allows.
- B. A minimum of one game a week will be played.
- C. A full refund will be given if there are fewer than six teams to form a league.

### **TEAM CLASSIFICATION**

- A. If circumstances permit, teams may be placed in divisions.
- B. Teams must complete the team placement form and return it with the roster.
- C. Final decision will be made by the Tualatin Hills Sports Office.

# **LEAGUE PLAY**

## **COED LEAGUE**

1. **DATES:** Weeknights beginning week of June 1<sup>st</sup> through August 13<sup>th</sup> (pending rainouts)
2. **GAMES TIMES:** 6:30, 7:50 and 9:10 pm for games on THPRD Complexes.
3. **FIELDS:** THPRD HMT and PCC/Rock Creek Complex fields and BSD school fields.
4. **MAKEUPS:** Makeup games may be scheduled as double headers and may be played as days/field availability permit.
5. **PLAYOFFS:** NO PLAYOFFS WILL BE HELD IN THE COED DIVISION unless scheduling allows.

## **MEN'S LEAGUE**

1. **DATES:** Weekdays beginning the week of June 1<sup>st</sup> through August 13<sup>th</sup> (pending rainouts).
2. **GAME TIME:** 5:00 pm ONLY
3. **FIELDS:** THPRD HMT and PCC/Rock Creek Complex fields.
4. **MAKEUPS:** Makeup games may be scheduled as schedules and field availability permit.
5. **PLAYOFFS:** Beginning about August 6 (pending rainouts). Playoffs will be open to the top teams.

## **AWARDS**

1. Awards will be given to top teams in each division.
2. All awards will be awarded at the end of the season.

## **LEAGUE RULES**

1. All divisions will abide by the 2010 NSA rules with the exception of minor league changes adopted by the Tualatin Hills Softball Steering Committee.
2. Coed teams must have a minimum of 8 players (4 men/4 women) to start or continue a game.
3. Men's teams must have a minimum of 8 players to start or continue a game.

## **ROSTER CHECKS**

1. All players must bring picture ID to all games. Players without adequate ID will not be eligible to play. Players not listed on the official roster will not be eligible to participate in any games (exception: Ghost players). Teams found to be using illegal players or players without proper ID during the game will forfeit that game.

## **FORFEITS**

1. Any team which forfeits two games will be dropped from the league and forfeit all fees paid.

## **UMPIRES**

1. One umpire per game will be assigned.
2. Anyone interested in becoming an official should call the District office.

## **EQUIPMENT**

1. All softball equipment, except game balls and score book must be supplied by the teams.
2. All 12" softballs used in a game must be .44 COR balls.
3. All players must wear shirts with 6" numbers on the back. Matching shirts are highly recommended.
4. Bats deemed illegal by NSA will not be allowed in league play. Please visit [www.PlayNSA.com](http://www.PlayNSA.com) for a list of legal bats.

## **PRACTICE FIELD RESERVATIONS**

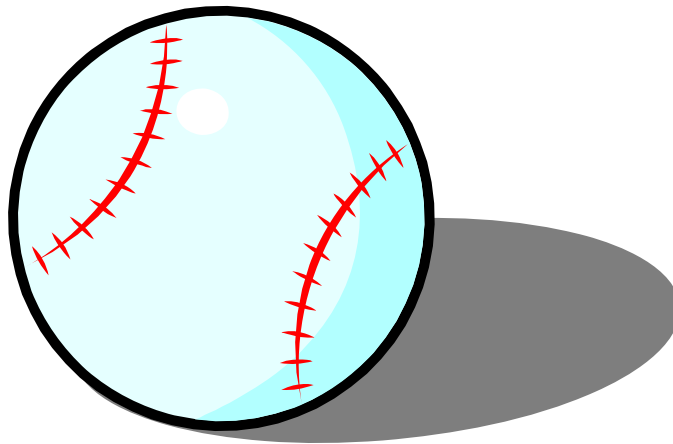
1. Practice fields are available on a limited basis.
2. Reservations must be made in person at the THPRD Sports Office. Teams may reserve one field per week.

## **TOURNAMENTS**

1. All tournament invitations sent to THPRD are compiled in a softball tournament notebook kept at the THPRD office. Teams interested in tournaments should check this notebook throughout the season.

## **OTHER**

1. **INSURANCE** - THPRD or the Softball Association does not supply Insurance. All players play at their own risk.
2. **ROSTER ADDITIONS** - Players may be added to the roster anytime prior to your seventh league game. Players must submit copies of appropriate I.D. with the add form before being allowed to participate in a game.

## THPRD Residency Card

**A valid THPRD Residency Card is required for all program and activity registrations**

A [Residency Card Form](#) is available online or at any THPRD facility. Completed forms may be brought to any THPRD facility (with required identification) for processing.

**Proof of residency verification:**

Current Oregon Drivers License, Oregon Identification Card, or DMV receipt.

**Plus** ONE of the following (it must be current and have your address printed on it):

- \* Property tax statement
- \* Utility Bill (gas, electric, telephone, water)
- \* Insurance Card
- \* Bank or Credit Card Statement
- \* Lease Agreement

To ensure priority in all District programs, activities and facilities, THPRD encourages all household members to obtain a residency card. Cards are free and valid for three years if homeowner and one year if renter/other. Replacements cards are \$5.00. THPRD reserves the right to verify residency without notice. In-District privileges may be withheld until residency can be verified.

Adult League Sports "Photo" Residency Cards are obtained in person at the Tualatin Hills Athletic Center ONLY, 50 NW 158<sup>th</sup> Ave, 8:00am-9:00pm. .

**Out-of District Resident Assessment Fee:**

People living outside the District are welcomed and encouraged to enjoy the activities and services provided by the Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District. An annual fee of \$268 will be assessed to out-of-District individuals or households who wish to register and/or participate in THPRD classes and programs. Those individuals or household who pay the annual assessment fee will receive in-District rates on all THPRD classes, programs, and frequent user passes and drop-in programs.

- Out-of-District residents may pay the annual assessment fee on a quarterly basis (\$67) as they register for classes or programs
- Out of District senior and disabled classes and programs will be included in the in-district rate with the paid annual assessment fee, however without subsidies.
- The annual assessment fee will apply to out-of-District youth and adults participating in THPRD sports leagues and/or affiliate sports leagues. *(All out-of-District youth and adults must now register with the Park District prior to sign-ups to participate in all THPRD and affiliate sports leagues.)*
- In-District residents will still have first priority when registering for classes and programs.

The intent of this annual assessment fee policy as adopted by the Tualatin Hills Park and Recreation District Board of Directors is to establish fair and equitable fees and charges for use of District facilities and programs by Park District and non Park District users.
