

BADMINTON/PICKLEBALL GUIDELINES

THPRD is committed to providing programs and facilities that feel welcoming, safe, and comfortable for everyone. For appropriate behavior, please refer to the Drop-In Rules.

- All players are expected to respect fellow players' skill sets and allow equal playing time.
- Games will be played to 21 for badminton and 11 for pickleball.
- Do not move or use anyone else's paddle or racquet.
- Everyone is expected to be honest and mature when resolving disputes about scores or boundaries.
 - If you cannot resolve a disputed call within 10 seconds, replay that point and move on with the game.
- Follow each specific center's method of lining up your paddle or racquet.

Court Rotation

When fewer than six paddles or racquets are in the queue, two players rotate onto the next available court.

When six or more paddles or racquets are in the queue, four players rotate onto the next available court.

We reserve the right to exclude individuals who do not follow the Drop-In Rules, Guidelines, and Code of Conduct.
