

FAQ: Shelter and Park Reservations

Where do I find the application to reserve a shelter or park?

The Reservation form can be found at www.thprd.org/parks-and-trails/park-rentals or contact THPRD via our reservation email at parkreservations@thprd.org.

Reservations for Camp Rivendale are made with staff at the Jenkins Estate: 971-258-6743.

What is the deadline to reserve a shelter or park?

Requests must be made at least 72 hours prior to requested use date.

Are there specific times available to reserve a shelter or park?

Shelters may be reserved from 8:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. or 3:00 p.m. to dusk. If both time blocks are available, the shelter can be reserved for both time blocks (all day). If the entire block is not needed, please indicate the time on the reservation form (there is no deduction for shorter time use).

What if I need to cancel my reservation?

Refunds will not be issued due to inclement weather or violation of Park Rules and Regulations.

Shelter and park rules, to sign off on and share with your guests.

- The park area(s) must be cleaned following the event. Staples may NOT be used to attach tablecloths, decorations, signs, etc. to picnic tables, shelters, or trees.
- No littering, including confetti, glitter, any decorations which could be timeconsuming or difficult to clean up.
- Please bring an extra bag or two for garbage and take it out. This protects the
 animals from getting into any food scraps and leaves the permanent garbage cans
 available to other park guests.
- No amplified music/sound.
- No vandalism or graffiti.
- Cannot exceed rental time established on the reservation form.
- Park spaces near the shelter or other park picnic areas are open to the public (ex. Playgrounds, other picnic tables in the park, bocci courts, etc.)
- Smoking is not allowed in or around shelters or on any THPRD property.
- Dogs must be on a leash and waste must be disposed of properly.
- Parking: there are no reserved parking areas. Neighborhoods have very little on-street parking.
- Vehicles are not allowed to drive into the park.
- Play structures or any other activity that participants climb in or on (e.g. bounce houses) are prohibited.

Can alcohol be at a shelter or park?

Alcoholic beverages are only authorized when the Alcohol Permit Section of the Park Reservation application has been approved and signed by the General Manager/designee. Additional forms are required

Is there electricity at the shelters?

Most Tier 3 shelters have electricity.

• These outlets are for small wattage uses. Outlets will not support food carts, or other like uses.

Are barbeques allowed?

Shelters with barbeques (briquette) can be found at:

- Tier 1 sites: Camp Rivendale, Raleigh Park
- Tier 2 sites: Evelyn M. Schiffler Park, Barsotti Park, and Jackie Husen Park

Or you can bring your own. Personal barbeques cannot be placed on picnic tables.

Please make sure that briquettes have no heat; and any drippings or residue is cleaned for the next users and to protect the animals.

Are restrooms available?

All shelter sites have portable restrooms. Some sites have permanent restrooms but may be closed due to vandalism. Most park sites do not have portable restrooms.
