



# Top THPRD Parks to look for Reptiles

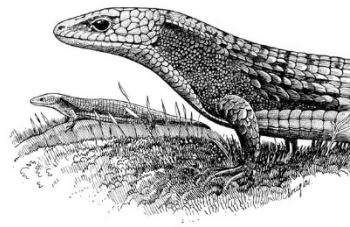
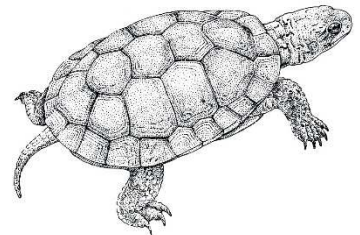

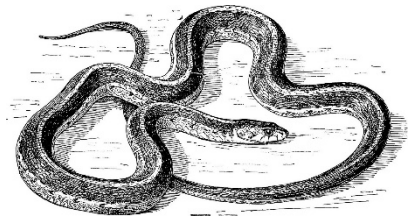
## Common reptiles found in THPRD parks:
