

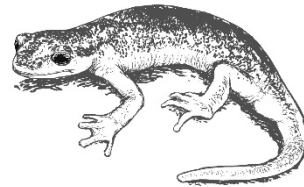


Top THPRD Parks to look for Amphibians

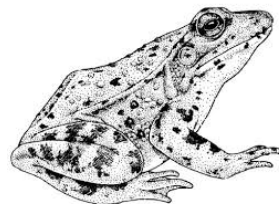
Common amphibians found in THPRD parks:

- Northern red-legged frog
- Rough-skinned newt

- Stoller Creek Greenway
- Vista Brook Park
