- ❑ **Barrows Park**, Yarrow, *Achillea millefolium*
- ❑ **Camille Park**, Common camas, *Camassia quamash*
- ❑ **Fanno Creek Trail (SW 105th Ave. to Allen Blvd.)**,
Western skunk cabbage, *Lysichiton americanus*
- ❑ **Fanno Creek Greenway**: Meadow checker-mallow,
Sidalcea campestris
- ❑ **Hansen Ridge Park**: Streambank lupine, *Lupinus rivularis*
- ❑ **Jenkins Estate**: Oregon fawn lily, *Erythronium oregonum*
- ❑ **Kaiser Woods**: Inside-out flower, *Vancouveria hexandra*
- ❑ **Mitchell Park**: Smooth yellow violet, *viola glabella*
- ❑ **Mt. Williams Park**: Western trillium, *Trillium ovatum*
- ❑ **Willow Creek Greenway**: Fringecup, *Tellima grandiflora*

Bonus park:

- ❑ **H.M.Terpenning Recreation Complex**: Star Solomon's seal,
Maianthemum stellatum
