



Top Ten THPRD Parks to discover Northwest Native Plants

Explore the parks below and search for the prominent native plant found at that site. Be sure to check out the Top Ten THPRD Parks for Wildflowers to discover some of our native wildflowers, not included below.

- Autumn Ridge Park:** Common snowberry, *Symphoricarpos albus*
- Bauman Woods:** Indian plum, *Oemleria cerasiformis*
- Bluffs Park:** Oceanspray, *Holodiscus discolor*
- Granada Woods:** Salal, *Gaultheria shallon*
- Hideaway Park:** Douglas spiraea, *Spiraea douglasii*
- Lilly K. Johnson Woods:** Vine maple, *Acer circinatum*
- Melilah Park:** Western sword fern, *Polystichum munitum*
- Pioneer Park:** Red osier dogwood, *Cornus sericea*
- Ridgewood View Park:** Serviceberry, *Amelanchier alnifolia*
- Roy E. Dancer Park:** Tall Oregon grape, *Mahonia aquifolium*

Bonus park:

- Morrison Woods:** Thimbleberry, *Rubus parviflorus*
