



TUALATIN HILLS SOFTBALL PROGRAM High School Open: Summer 2024 League Information & Registration Procedures

ALL PLAYERS PLAY AT THEIR OWN RISK Registration Deadline: Friday April 26th, 2024- 7pm

TEAM FEES

Option #1: Register as a whole team, turn in roster at time of registration- \$300. No need for out-of-district players to pay assessment fee.

Option #2: Register as an individual and we will place you on a team- \$30

- Submit roster in person or email to <u>k.kotchik@thprd.org</u>. Payments can be in person or via link to pay after roster is emailed.
- League fees cover direct costs; umpires, game balls, rulebooks, scorebooks, and supervisors.
- Any team dropping from the league after the league schedules have been completed **WILL NOT** receive a refund of league fees.
- All in-district and out-of-district players must have a valid THPRD Residency Card. Please call the Athletic Center front desk (503-629-6330) for THPRD Residency Card. (FREE)

ROSTERS

- 1. Complete the attached team roster in full.
- 2. A player may be registered on only **ONE** Tualatin Hills League team per night of league play.
- 3. Players must be currently in high school (including upcoming graduating seniors)
- 4. Rosters must list a minimum of 14 players.
- 5. Minimum of 7 females on the roster.
- 6. All in-district and out-of-district players must submit their valid THPRD I.D card number on the team roster. Please call the Athletic Center front desk (503-629-6330) to receive a THPRD I.D. card number.
- 7. If a team is in need of players, a list of enthusiastic softball players looking for a team to play on is kept at the THPRD Athletic Center office. Call (503) 629-6330 or stop by for a copy of the list.
- 8. Players will play as their affirmed gender. This means Trans Women are welcome in the Women's League and Trans Men will play in the Men's League, Non-Binary (NB) players are welcome in the Open League. Affirmed gender refers to lived in gender rather than as assigned at birth.
- 9. The Coed leagues have been renamed to the Open league.
- 10. Players who registered as an individual will be placed on teams by THPRD. THPRD will try to place based on experience and home high school.

- 5. **MAKEUPS:** Makeup games if schedule allows and may be played on other nights as schedules
- 6. Depending on number of teams there may be double headers.

LEAGUE RULES

1. All divisions will abide by the 2024 United Softball Association (USA) rules with the exception of minor league changes adopted by the Tualatin Hills Sports Department.

UMPIRE and COACHES

- 1. One umpire per league game will be assigned.
- 2. Anyone interested in becoming an official should call the Athletic Center office 503/629-6330.
- 3. There must be one 21+ coach present for each team at all games.
- 4. Coaches may pitch in place of players in the event team does not have a pitcher.

EQUIPMENT

- 1. All softball equipment will be provided by THPRD.
- 2. All softballs used in a game must be 12" 52/300 balls.
- 3. Matching shirts are highly recommended.
- 4. Bats deemed illegal by USA will not be allowed in league play. Please visit <u>http://www.teamusa.org/USA-Softball</u> for a list of legal bats.
- 5. No senior bats will be allowed.

OTHER

- 1. **INSURANCE:** THPRD or the Softball Association does not supply Insurance. All players play at their own risk.
