Nature walks & community workshops



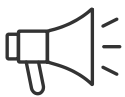
Projects connecting immigrant, refugee, or underrepresented groups to THPRD

## Who Can Apply?

- Community-based organizations
- Cultural groups or nonprofits
- Informal community coalitions with strong local ties

*You don't need to be a formal non-profit - just deeply connected to your community.*

## How Much Funding?

- Up to \$2,500 per project
- Rolling applications open Fall 2025
- Projects must be complete by June 30, 2026

## Co-Creation Model

Projects are built with the community, not just for them. The grant is available to support events in collaboration with THPRD. This means:

- Community-led ideas
- Representation & visibility
- Collaboration & trust-building
- Lasting connection between people, places, and programs

## How to Apply

1. Complete the short application by scanning the QR code or following the link
2. Reach out for support - brainstorming, spaces, or application prep.

### Applications reviewed monthly

- Applications close: 1st Wednesday
- Award notifications: 20th of the month
